PROGRAM OVERVIEW

PSOC-X is a 160+ hour certification program with four separate courses/modules of instruction.

Module-1 (PSOC-PAD): 'Protection Agent Development' is designed exclusively for executive protection, corporate security and LE/Mil professionals interested in learning how to provide lower visibility personal security for high net-worth or 'at risk' individuals in permissive to semi-permissive environments where a low to moderate threat exists. This highly academic and field based program creates a comprehensive and balanced foundation for prospective or current members of protective elements. It is the most progressive and relevant protective operations doctrine currently available for those wanting to learn modern EP practices.

Module-2 (PSOC-PPS): 'Protective Pistol Skills' is the weapons-centric component of PSOC and is entirely range-based. This allows students to focus their energies on safe and successful use of a concealed handgun during protective security operations. Students will learn both individual and team-based tactics with firearms.

Module-3 (PDOC): 'Protective Driving Operations Certification' teaches the fundamentals and techniques for safely moving a principle in a motor vehicle. Proper driving is a critical factor and requirement in protective operations. Students will learn everything from routine driving protocol to emergency vehicle operation and practically apply those skills during multiple exercises.

Module-4 (HTSOC): ‘High Threat Security Operations Certification’ is an intense and comprehensive 7-day course designed for the individual or security team operating in any environment or timeframe where a higher threat exists. Techniques, tactics and procedures taught in HTSOC apply to small teams or large teams, low profile or high profile operations, and domestic or international missions. Students will learn to meet high threat security needs as a result of their area of operation, localized risk of kidnapping or violent crime, or an unusual, specific threat made against a principle. Training methodologies range from conventional to unconventional and challenge students to perform. All instructors possess extensive, current real-world experience on high-risk U.S. domestic details and international high threat operations in Mexico, Central America, South America, Southeast Asia and the Middle East. This course presents not only the most cutting-edge hard skills related to weapons, vehicle operations and protective team tactics, it addresses the nuances and concepts for successfully working under high risk conditions that may complicate a security mission.

The PSOC Protection Agent Development course is the only EP training program in the United States fully certified by a major university for academic credit (UNLV) and the entire PSOC-X program is GSA certified for Federal Government and DoD personnel (GS-02F-0160V).

The primary goal of PSOC-X is to professionally educate and train those tasked with different types of protective operations. Students participating in this program will have varying degrees of expertise and experience. Regardless of background or current assignment, students are trained to operate on the same page. Due to this being a restricted enrollment course, prospective students must be prepared for a brief phone interview with a staff member from PFC to discuss work experience and previous training related to security and protective services. Additionally, students will be expected to sign and adhere to a non-disclosure agreement (NDA) upon the first day of class.
